Clause 3 Handweavers, Spinners and Dyers Guild Constitution 2021 Committee approval 10 October 2019	In order to encourage learning and the development of new skills for members, the HWSDG offers workshops for members and non-members, subject to availability. Learning can occur through informal attendance on meeting days or through planned workshops, tutorials and groups. HWSD Groups Currently, there are regular meeting days for Guild members throughout the state. In addition, there are special interest groups, e.g. weaving, felting, spinning, discussion groups etc. Experienced members who share their skills and facilitate these sessions are not paid for their time or expertise. This includes assisting new members to develop skills associated with HWSDG. Members can attend at any time and no enrolment is required. There is a nominal charge to cover tea, coffee and insurance.
Reviewed by Committee and Tabled AGM: 14/03/2023 Committee	Standard Payments to Presenters There is a need to respect the expertise of all tutors whether they are experienced Guild members or outside tutors. The Guild acknowledges the preparation time required for each workshop. In the past some Guild members have conducted workshops and classes and have not been paid. The Committee agreed that all tutors should be paid per face-to-face teaching hour that includes acknowledgement of preparation time.
review of fee structure 21 Sept 2023. Approval of changes to tutor assistant payment 8 February 2024	 Tutors: \$50 per hour for agreed contracted time Tutor Assistant: \$50 per workshop Participants: \$10 per hour (members); and \$15 per hour (non-members) Workshops of longer than four hours duration, will have a designated meal break and morning/afternoon tea breaks, equivalent to 1 hour. This will not be paid time for tutors or charged to participants. For example – a workshop runs from 10:00am to 4:00pm (6 hours) the time paid/charged is 5 hours to allow for the breaks.

Most workshops will have a minimum of 5-6 participants depending on duration, and maximum of 10-12 according to the preference of the tutor and the space available in the location used.

Fees for external tutors

The fees for external tutors will be set at \$50 per hour unless otherwise agreed with the tutor. This may include the committee approving payment of travel/accommodation for the visiting tutor.

Review

The fee structure will be reviewed every year in the September Committee meeting.
